LOOP Talks 2022

The LOOP Talks are a series of roundtable discussions, one-to-one conversations and professional gatherings exploring artists' film and video. By bringing together international art experts, these 2-day marathons look into analysing the modes of film practices both formally and conceptually, putting forth questions on how the moving image is produced, perceived and circulated within and outside the gallery space.

On the occasion of this year's edition, the programme will expand the debate on the ethics and practices of collecting, departing from the idea that video, for its very own nature, requires attentive and committed companions. This way, the 2-day meeting will look into collecting as a form of cultural production and dig into the notion of custodianship. At the same time, the sessions will also present distinguished experiences of shared collecting and a new code of conduct for committed collectors. To wrap up the programme, an introduction on how the advent of new digital policies had a twofold effect on production and acquisitions and a 'bonus-track-presentation' of a cutting edge project to showcase video art in the public space.
